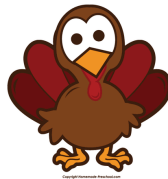
Michael is a BC writer, artist and historian. He will be stopping in Radium to give a talk on his latest graphic novel-- Julia.

## AUTHOR TOUR: MICHAEL KLUCKNER



**The Extraordinary Life of Julia Henshaw**  
A graphic biography by Michael Kluckner

Julia Henshaw was a novelist, journalist, botanist, explorer and World War I ambulance driver who won the French Croix de guerre exactly 100 years ago.

This book follows her eventful life from Montreal to Vancouver, from Berlin to London, and from the mining towns of the Kootenays to the battlefields of France and Belgium, including her interest in alpine botany that led to the publication of "Mountain Wild Flowers" in 1906. She lived in the Vancouver area from 1886 until her death in 1937.

Michael Kluckner is the author of numerous books about British Columbia, BC and Canada, as well as the graphic novel *Julia* (2016).
