

CALL FOR VOLUNTEER RADIUM HOT SPRINGS PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD TRUSTEE

In accordance with the *BC Library Act*, the Village of Radium Hot Springs is inviting applications for someone to serve as a trustee on the Radium Hot Springs Public Library Board.

The Term of Office is for two years and the trustee is eligible for reappointment up to a maximum of eight years. The term commences January 1, 2019.

To be eligible to serve as a Trustee, you must be a resident or elector of the Village of Radium Hot Springs.

The successful candidate must possess a strong sense of community service, a willingness to work respectfully as part of a team, have strong communication skills, and be a library advocate.
